Tuition Schedule  
One half of the total tuition is due on or before June 10, 2011. The remaining balance is due on or before July 15, 2011. Adventure camp payments are due each Monday throughout the summer sessions.

Collection of Past Due

Attendance Policy

There will be supervised recesses from 9:15-9:30 everyday. During recess there will be snacks available. There is also a supervised lunch from 12:00-12:45. Your child does not need to be in adventure camp during these times.

#### Recess Snacks

Adventure Camp is our new program that involves age appropriate, exciting activities and organized events while students wait for their parents/guardians to pick them up. ## Course Descriptions

Session I  
June 13 – July 1
